SUBJECT: U.S. Army Corps of Engineers *Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) Work Plan for the Former Trabuco Bombing Range*—Los Angeles District Formerly Used Defense Site (FUDS) J09CA020900

Enclosed for your files is the *Final Former Trabuco Bombing Range Remedial Investigation Work Plan*. The Work Plan includes: the strategy developed during the Technical Project Planning Process as refined by stakeholder comments and the detailed execution plans. This work plan and the subsequent field implementation represent a significant step for this High Priority Formerly Used Defense Site (FUDS). This is the first FUDS Military Munitions Response Program (MMRP) RI/FS in California for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

The Work Plan outlines a field investigation that will provide data to augment the Conceptual Site Model to estimate the location, concentration, and nature of munitions and explosives of concern (MEC) at the former bombing range. The information will be used to determine a remedial alternative that will serve as the Final Remedy for the site. In addition, soil sampling activities will be completed to assess the possible contaminant release to the environment associated with munitions constituents (MC); the MC Sampling and Analysis Plan is included as Appendix E.

The Draft Final Work Plan was released in June 2005 and we appreciate your comments on that plan. The reviewers' accessibility and assistance to the USACE project delivery team in finalizing the Work Plan have greatly contributed to the process and resulted in a much improved Work Plan.

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers looks forward to initiating the field work at the site later this month in order to develop a long-term solution for MEC at the former bombing range.

Again, please contact me if you have any questions or comments, and look out for our project updates as we will routinely post the results of our investigations.
