

# Removal Actions Under The FUDS Program

## Time Critical Removal Action 2004

- Action Memorandum Signed January 9, 2004
- Draft Work Plan Issued February 18, 2004, and Final April 30, 2005
- Field work initiated May 10, 2004, and was completed May 26, 2004
  - In that time 265 subsurface anomalies were identified and excavated
  - TCRA was 3,300 feet long by avg. of 22 feet wide, ~2 acres
- Found:
  - Nine 3-lb practice bombs, all inert
  - One 25-lb practice bomb, inert
  - One 2.25-inch subcaliber aircraft-training rocket, these were inert from the start
  - One 5-inch aircraft training rocket head only - no rocket body found, these were inert from the start
- No 'live' MEC found during the TCRA
- Completion Report Draft November 29, 2004, and Final February 10, 2005
